Local Government

The progressive attitude of Sioux Center is lead by the city manager, mayor, and city council structure, who strive to make the community a thriving place to do business and live. A city and county zoning ordinance are designed to meet building codes and to maintain attractiveness. Municipal services including electric, natural gas, water, and sewer treatment are owned by the city. The tax structure consists of Local Sales Tax at 1% and State at 6%.

- ☞ A Christian liberal arts school, Dordt College, is located in Sioux Center and is fully accredited with an enrollment of 1,330 students.

- ☞ Northwest Iowa Community College, only 25 miles from Sioux Center, has an enrollment of 1,615 students.
