Sioux Center's Highway 75 Reconstruction project will encompass 2 ½ miles of the corridor focusing on the following key elements:


- Safety


Construction is planned for 2023-24!

Design Overview

- Preliminary Concept Developed
 - 20th Street S to 12th Street N
- Roadway Widths Defined
- Desired Speed Limits Submitted
- 4 Lane Roadway, Center Median with Left Hand Turn Lanes
- New Sidewalks along length of project



- Center Median and Turn Lanes added for Safety
- Pedestrian / Bike Path on East Side of HWY 75
- Improved 16th St. S intersection



- Realigned intersection at 13th St. SW
- Center Median continues

12th St. S to 8th St. S



- Enhanced Pedestrian Crossing at 10th St. S
- New Traffic Signal at 9th St. S

8th St. S to 4th St. S



- 7th Street SE closed to traffic to address misalignment at 7th Street SE and 7th Street SW

4th St. S to 1st Street



- Center Median continues
- Modified Post Office Entrance
- Modified intersection at 2nd Street S to resolve misalignment at 2nd Street SW and 2nd Street SE

1st Street to 4th St. N






1st Street to 4th St. N

- Chamber Building remains
- Center Median continues
- East Side on-street parking

4th St. N to 8th St. N






4th St. N to 8th St. N

- New Traffic Signal at 7th St. N
- Center Median continues

- Consolidated Access Points
- Future project from 12th St. N to HWY 18 anticipated in 2025

Streetscaping

- Streetscape Masterplan submitted to City Council
- Focus on Aesthetics to compliment Function and Safety
- Elements to be incorporated into corridor design



Safety Features

- Traffic Calming Considerations
 - Reduced Speed Limits
 - Reduced Lane Width
 - Center Medians
- Improved Pedestrian Crossings
- Conflict Points reduced at closed Medians





Timeline

- April 2021 – Preliminary Design Submittal
- Summer/Fall 2021 – DOT review / ROW acquisition process
- Winter 2021 – Final Design
- Spring 2022 – Final Design Review
- July 2022 – Final Plan Submittal
- January 2023 – Bid Letting
- Summer 23-24 – Construction
- Summer 2025 – Final Completion
